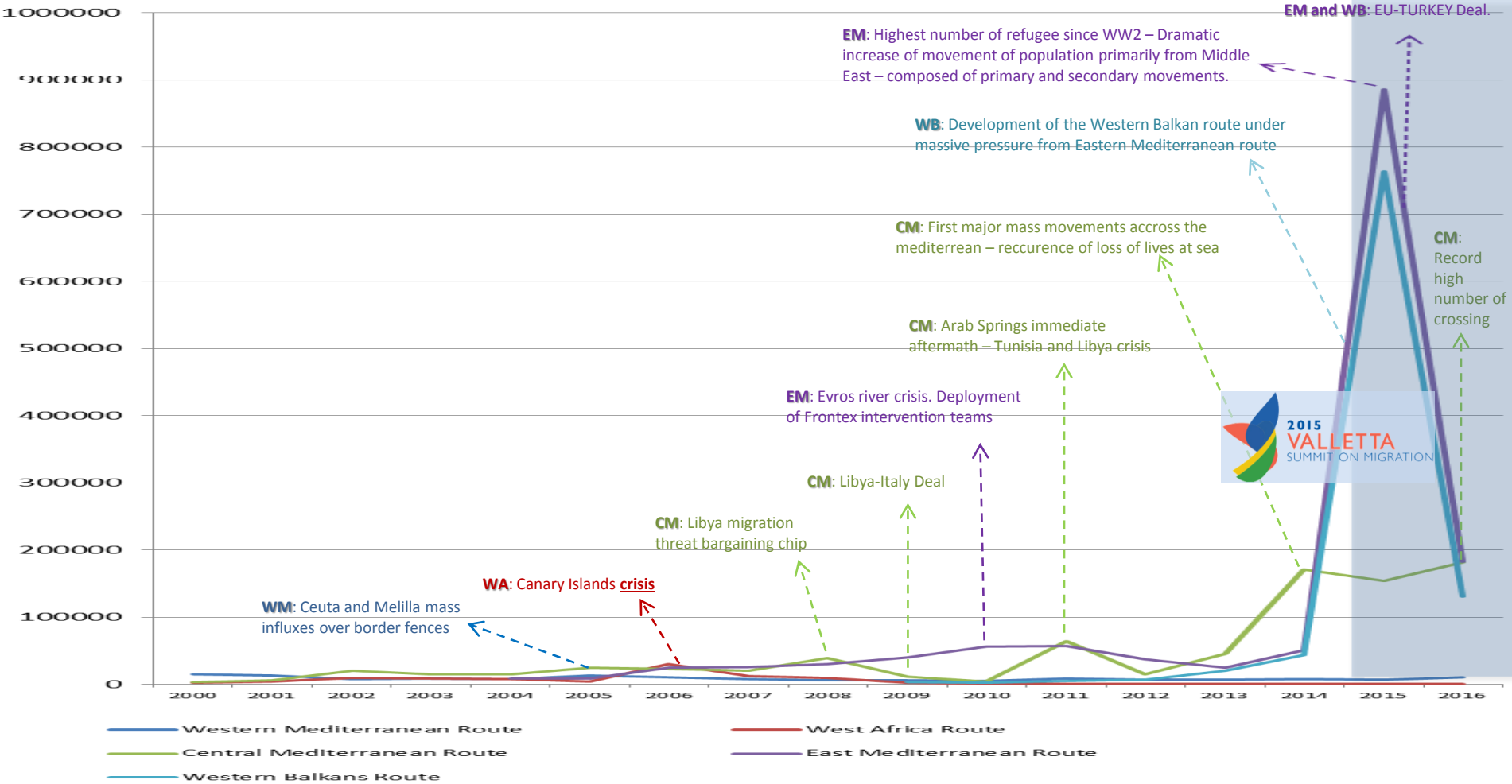

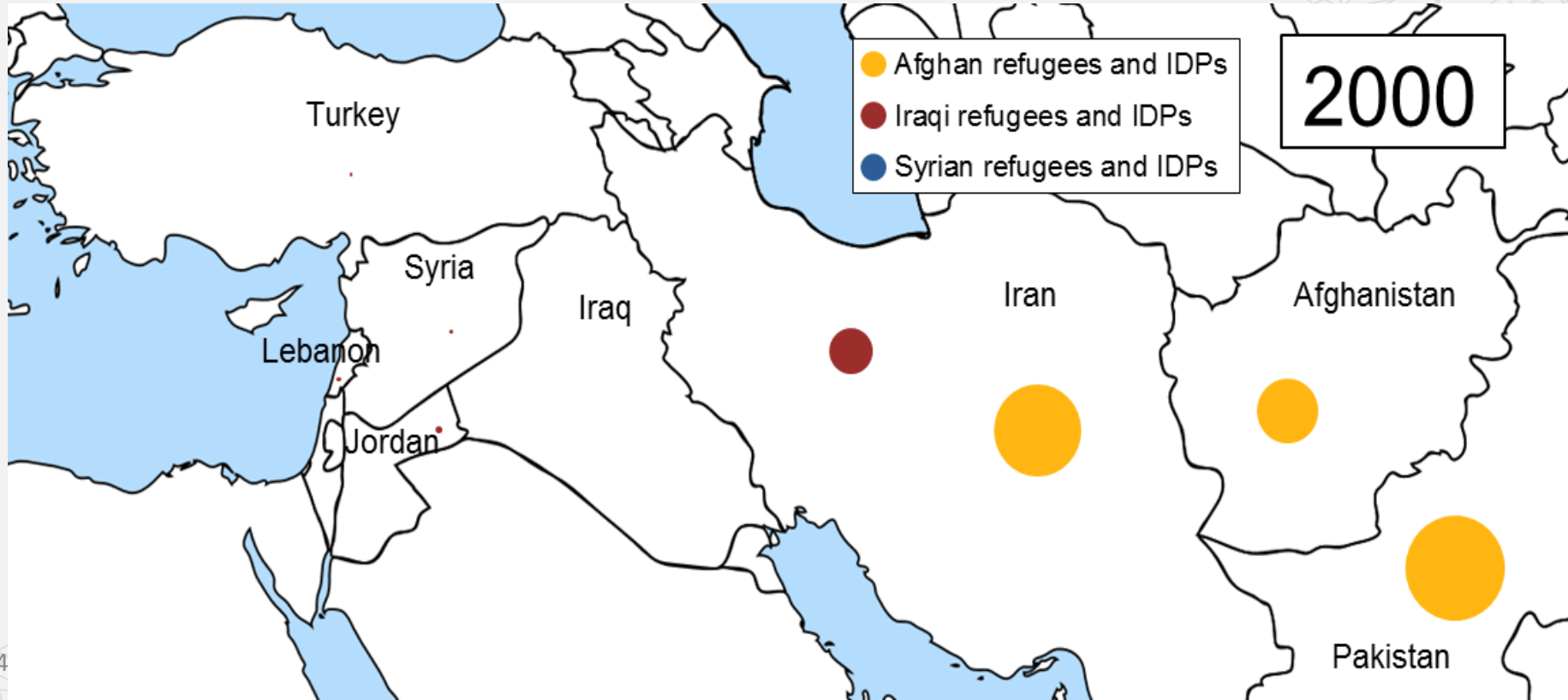

Evolution of Migration Trends According to the Number of Apprehended Migrants at Main Border Crossing Points



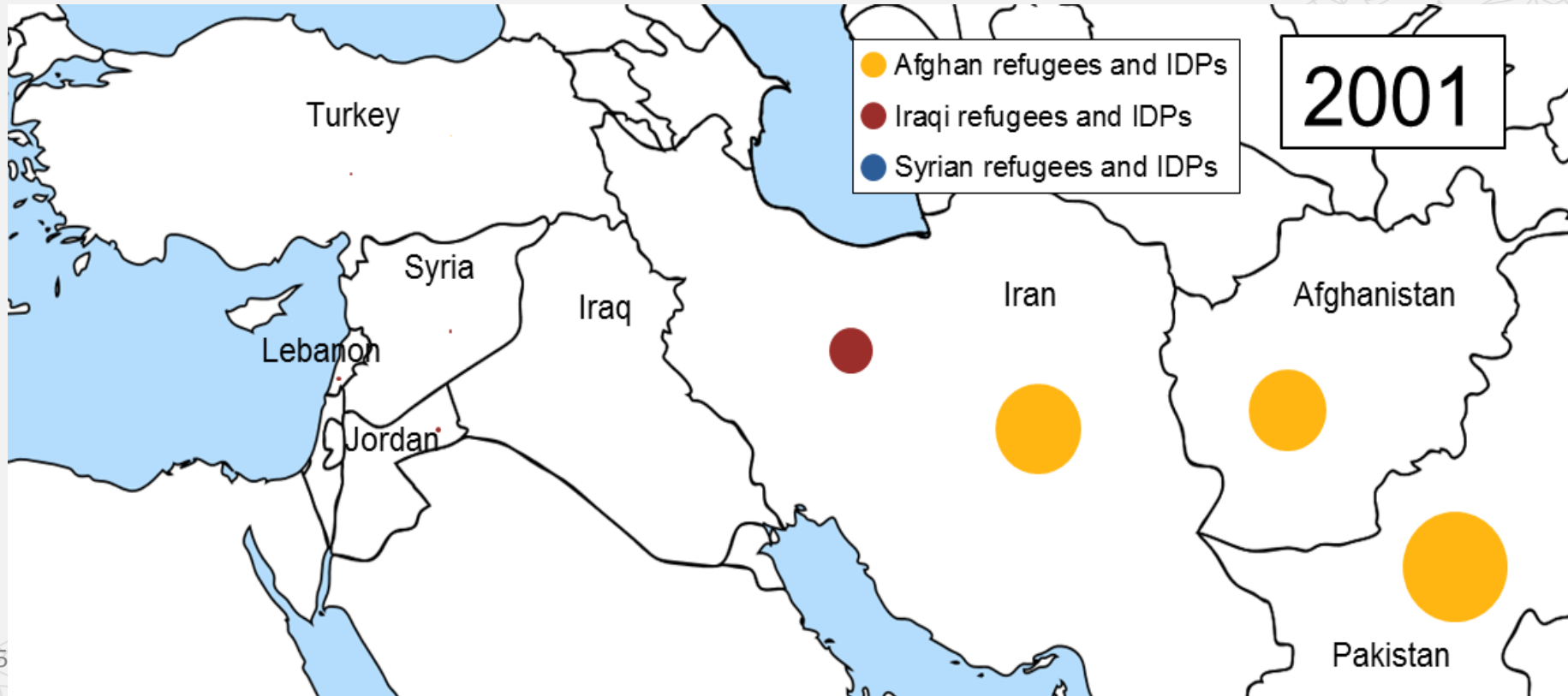

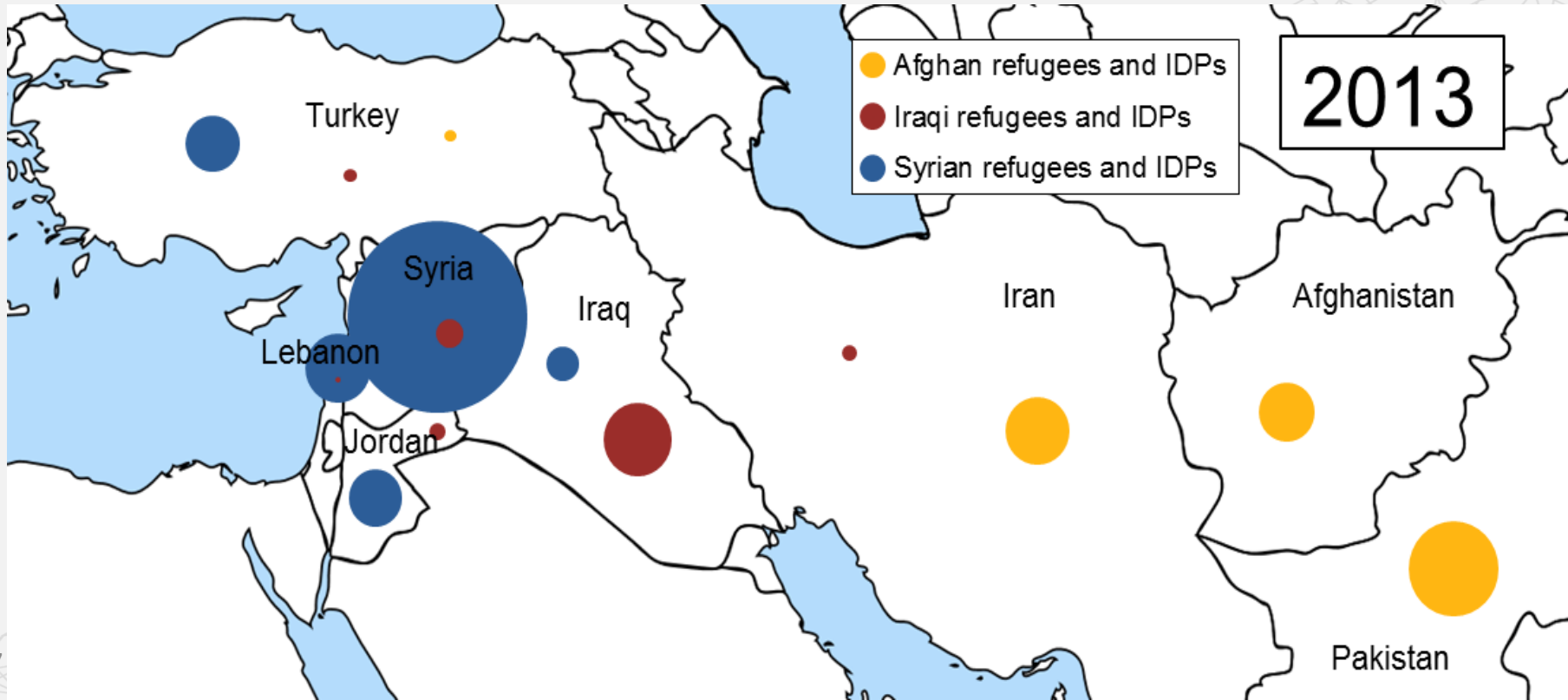

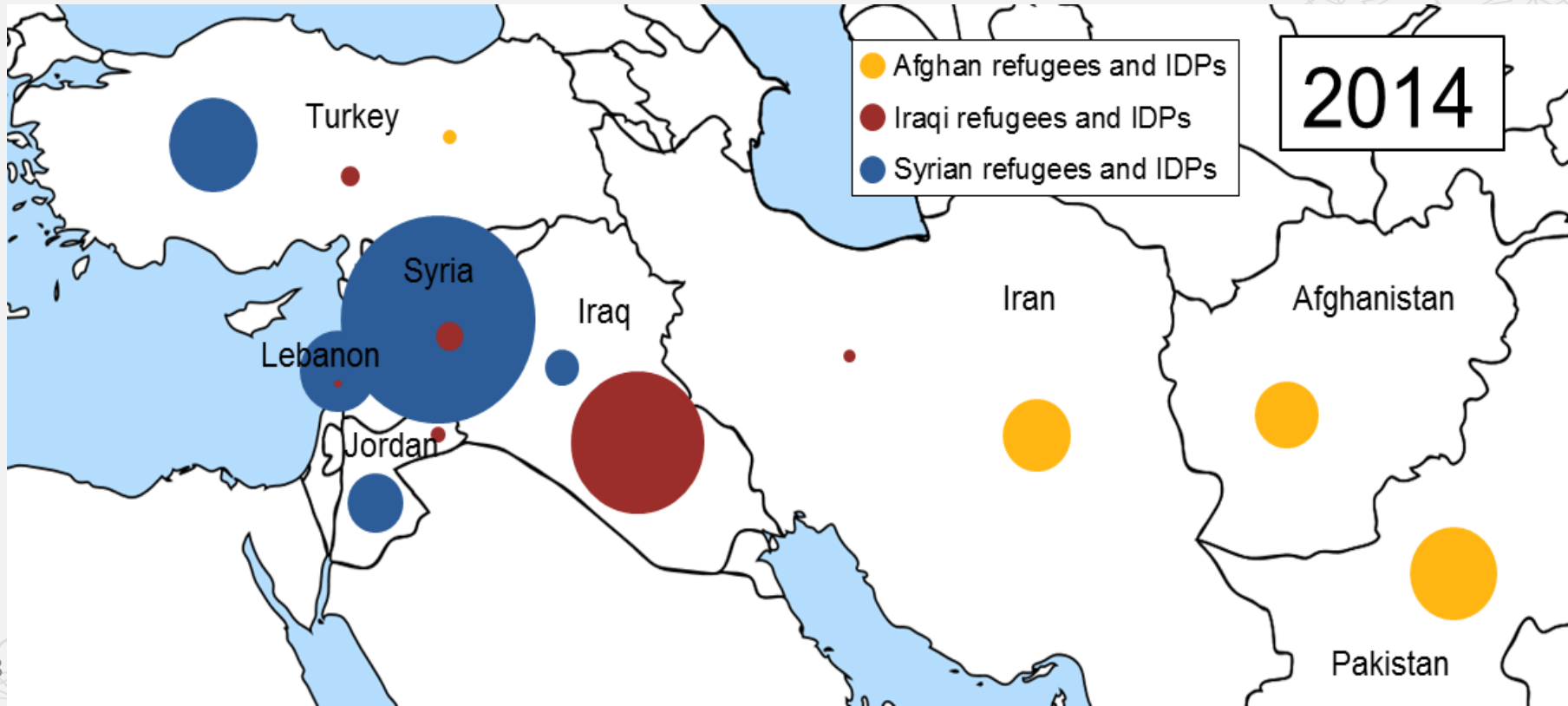

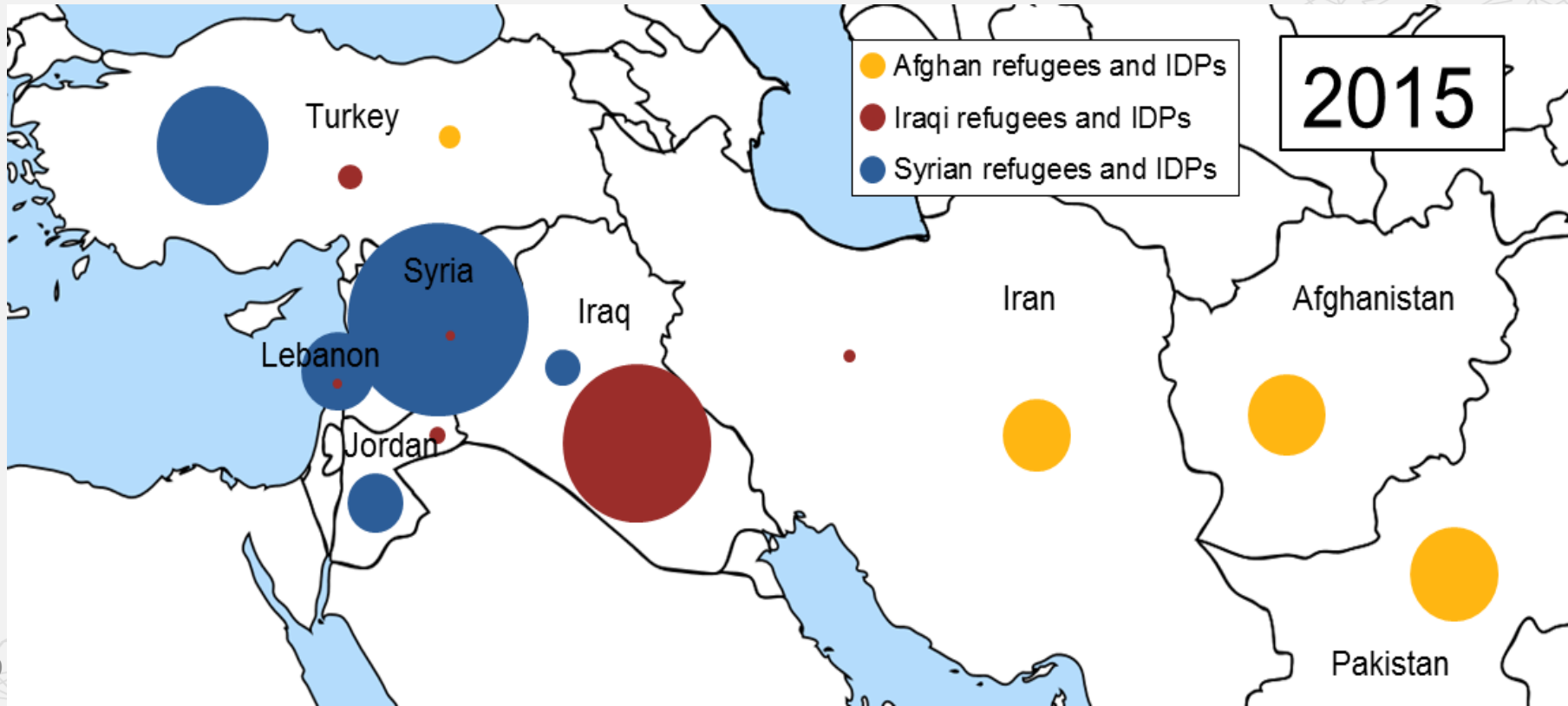

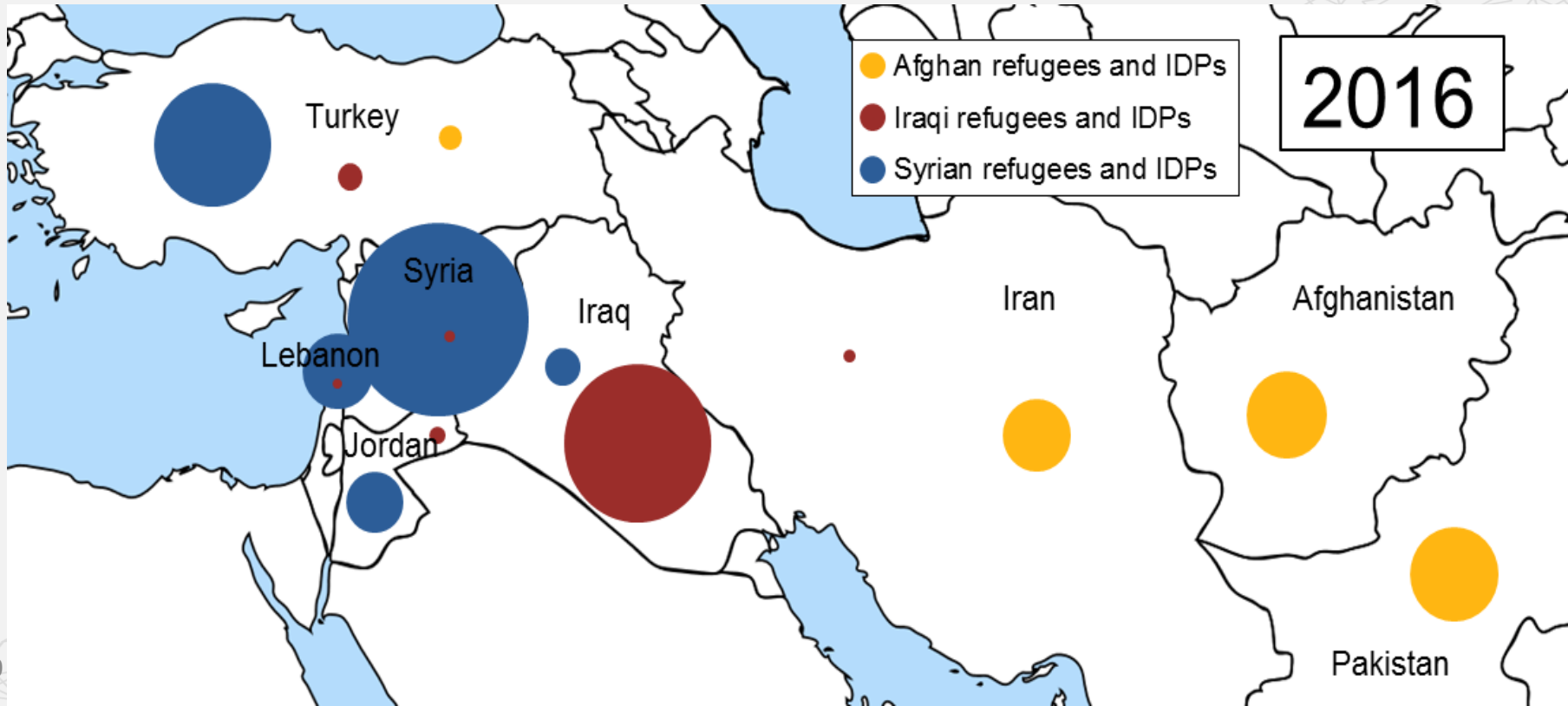


Fig.1 Trend of global displacement & proportion displaced | 1996 - 2015 (end-year)

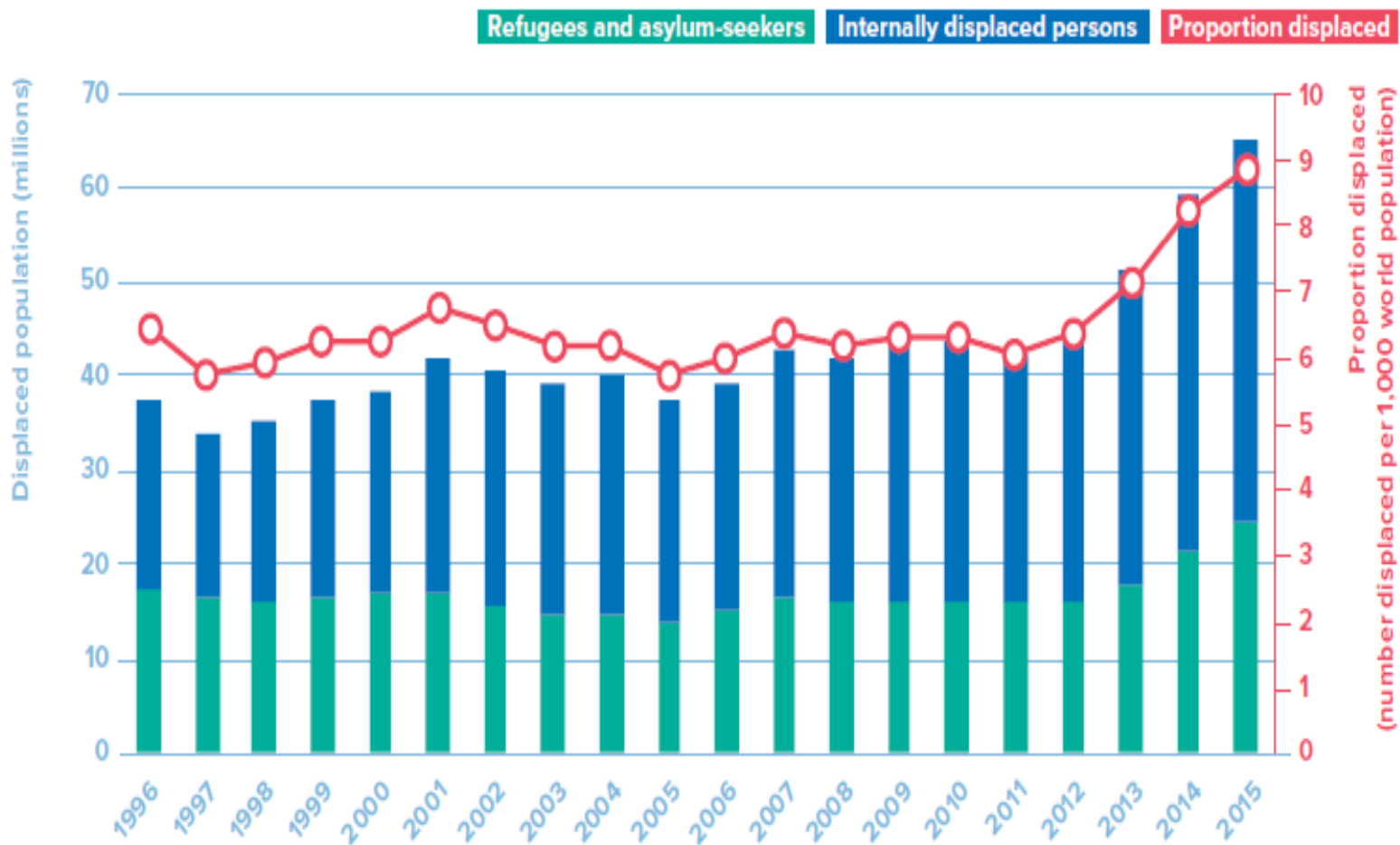
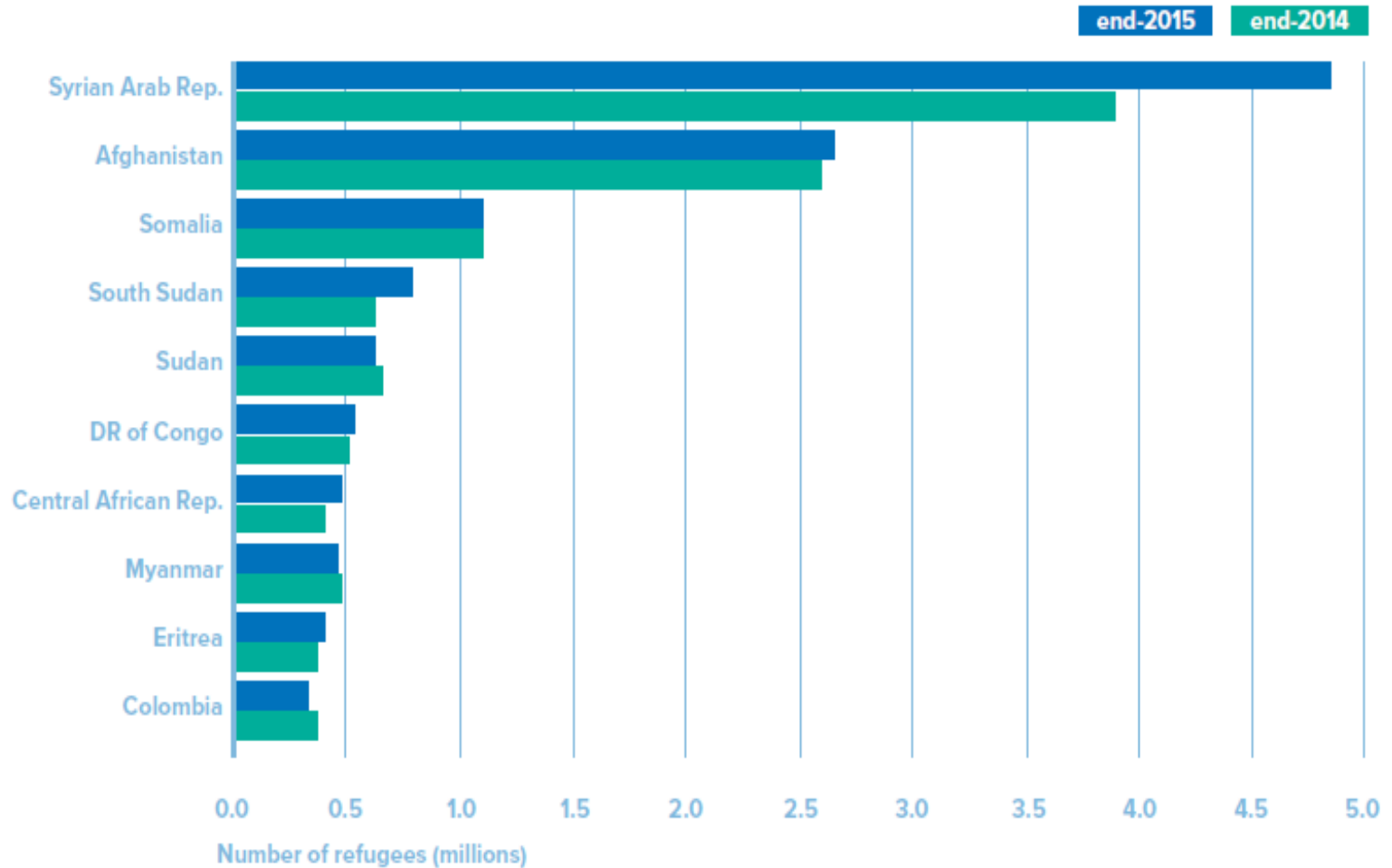
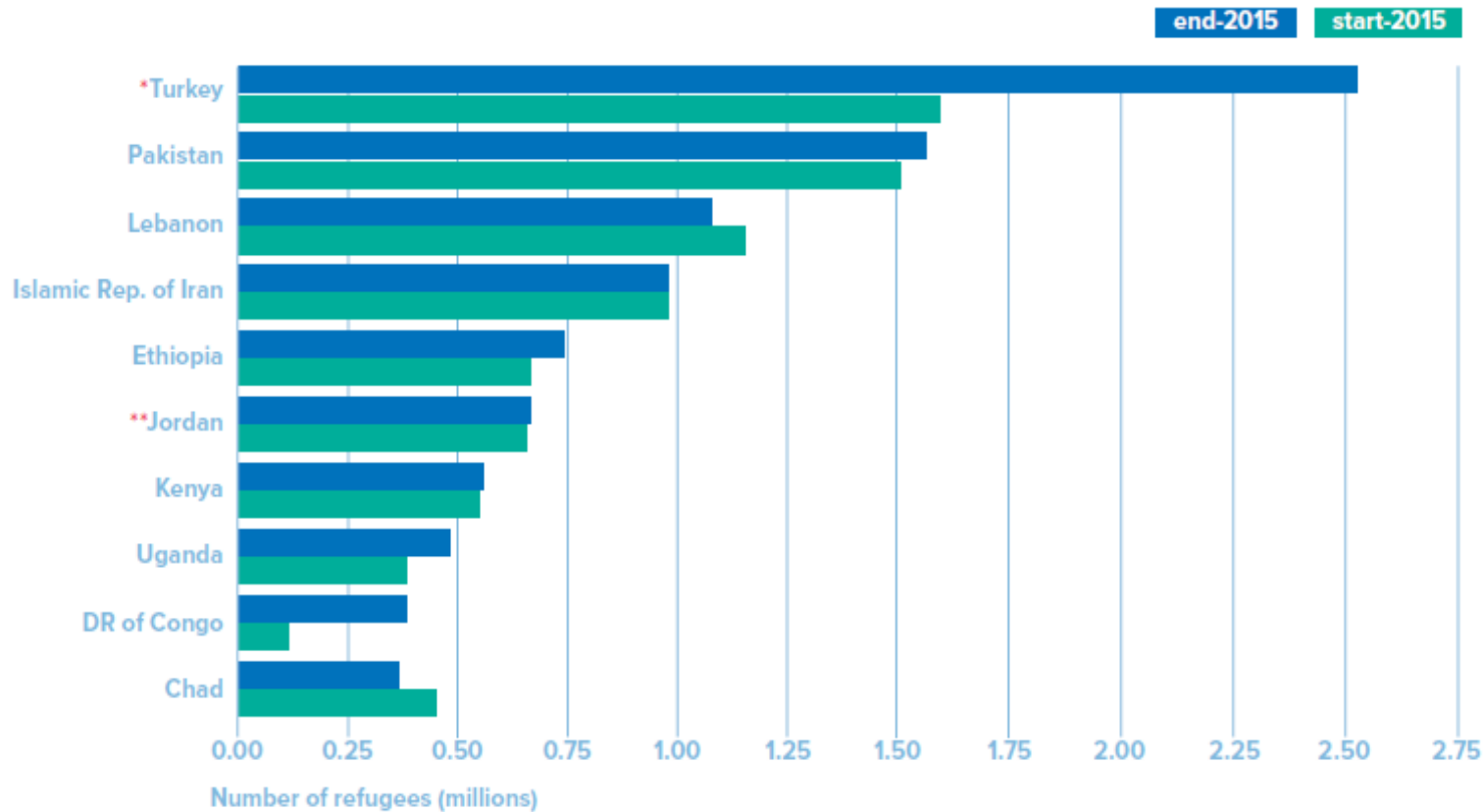


Fig.4 Major source countries of refugees | 2014 - 2015 (end-year)

Fig.3 Major refugee-hosting countries | 2014 - 2015 (end-year)



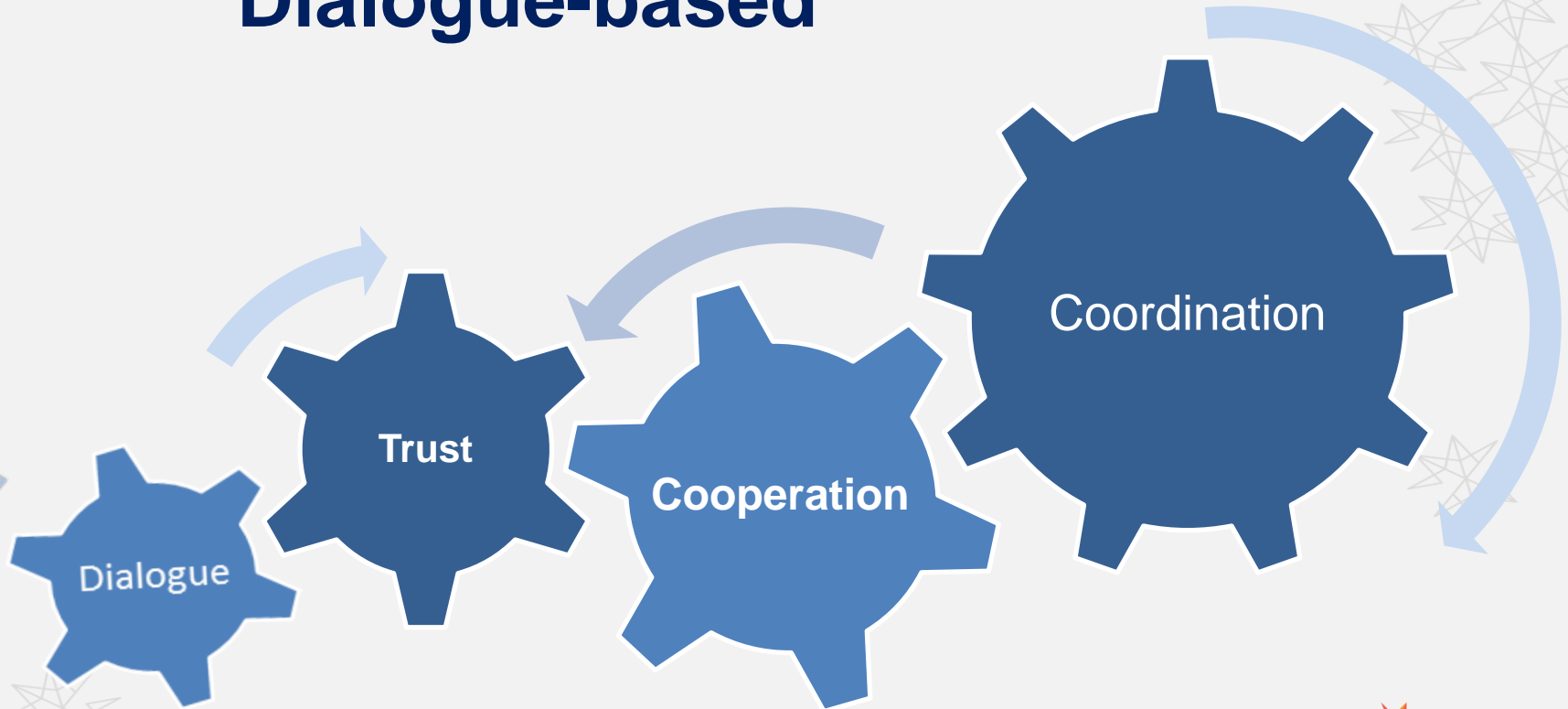

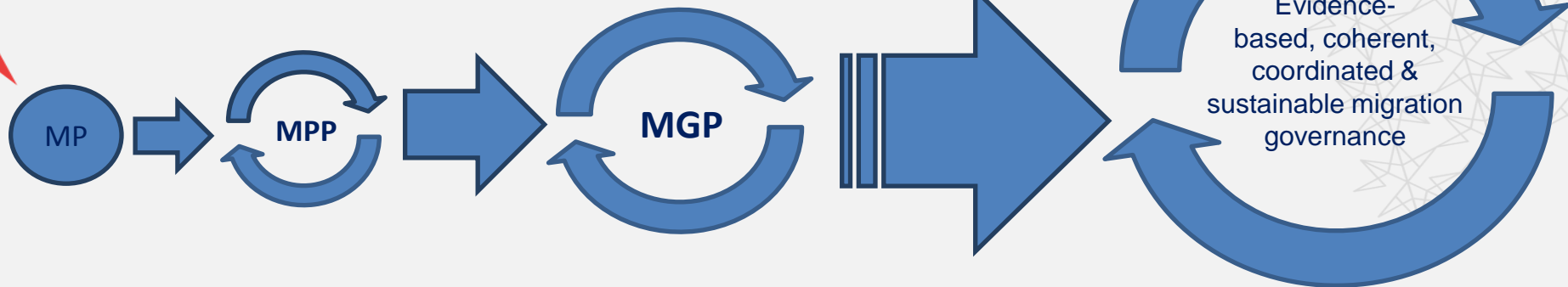

Action Plan

1. Development benefits of migration and addressing root causes
2. Legal migration and mobility
3. International protection and asylum
4. Prevention of and fight against irregular migration, migrant smuggling and trafficking in human beings
5. Making progress on return arrangements and readmission agreements

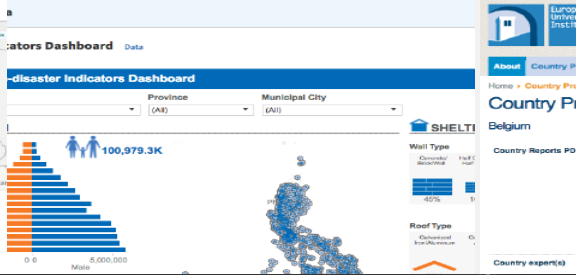
